Oakland Physician Inducted as a Fellow in the American College of Radiology

Reston, Va. – D. Jeffrey Demanes, M.D., FACR, of Oakland, Calif., has been inducted as a Fellow in the American College of Radiology (ACR). The induction took place at a formal convocation ceremony during the recent 84th ACR Annual Meeting and Chapter Leadership conference in Washington, D.C.

Demanes is a radiation oncologist with CA Endocurietherapy Medical Group, with hospital staff afiliations at Alta Bates Summit Medical Center (Sutter Health Systems Summit Campus, Oakland and Alta Bates Campus, Berkeley), John Muir Medical Center (Walnut Creek), Kaiser Permanente Medical Center (Oakland and San Francisco). He is clinical adjunct professor at Stanford University Medical Center, and has courtesy temporary privileges at numerous hospitals in the San Francisco Bay area. He is chairman of the ABS Economics Committee (1998-present) of the American Brachytherapy Society (of which he has been a member since 1982); served on various membership and chair positions on numerous committees and subcommittees (1998-present) of the American Society for Therapeutic Radiology & Oncology (member since 1984); on the board of directors (2000-present), fellow (2000), vice president of the American College of Radiation Oncology (ACRO) where he has been a member since 1990; member of ACRO Economics Committee 1998-present, chancellor (2003 & 2004), and president (2005 & 2006); member of the American College of Radiology (1998-present), the California Radiological Society (1988-present), the American Medical Association (1990-present), and the Association of Freestanding Radiation Oncology Centers (1995-present). Demanes earned his medical degree from the University of California at Los Angeles in 1974.
